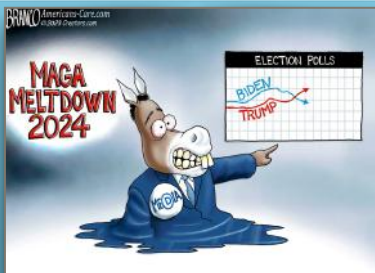

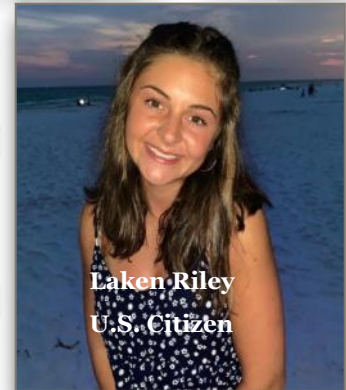

It is with a heavy heart that we reflect on the tragic loss of Laken Riley, a 22-year-old nursing student whose life was cut tragically short. This senseless act of violence, allegedly committed by an undocumented immigrant previously released due to a lack of detention capacity, this senseless murder could very well have been averted with more robust border security measures. The incident, which occurred in Athens, a city known for its sanctuary policies, serves as a painful reminder of the dire consequences of inadequate border control. The responsibility for this tragedy extends to the highest levels of government, underscoring the critical need for immediate and decisive action to ensure the safety and security of our communities.

Others have been spotted arriving on Varner Rd. and dispersing into our communities. We are at risk for these undocumented people to cause us harm.

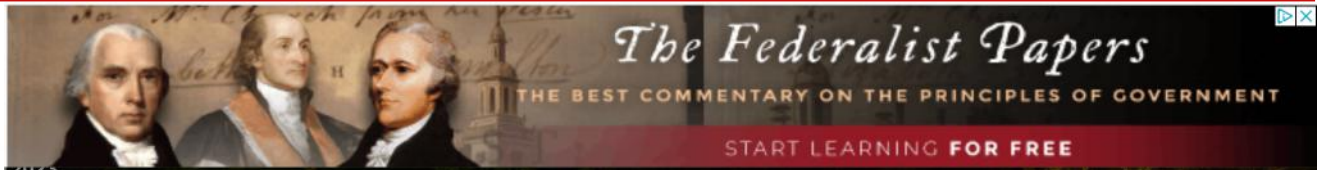

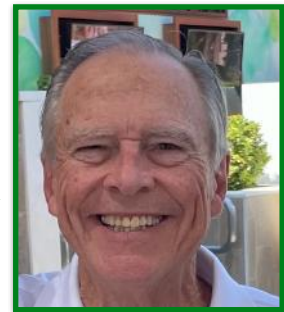

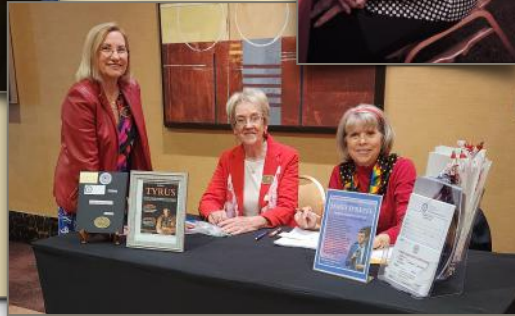

Holding Tyranny Accountable

From Legislation Chairman Arlene Wohlgemuth...

Ways Democrats Have Devalued Californians

A look at laws of the super-majority, Democrat legislature in the 2023-2024 session

Devaluation is defined by Oxford Languages as “the reduction or underestimation of the worth or importance of something.” We normally apply the term to economics and the value of a nation’s currency, but I believe the term is appropriate for what has happened to our culture – to individuals and families. These are just a few of the ways devaluation has occurred.

DEVALUATION OF PUBLIC EDUCATION is a serious issue for the future of our Republic. Beginning with the Supreme Court ruling, *Engels v Vitale*, forbidding prayer in schools and other lower court rulings that removed the Ten Commandments from school walls, a morality void was created. That void led to what we have now – replacing the teaching of classical education with social indoctrination, such as facilitating and teaching that boys can be girls and teachers being fired for refusing to lie to parents. Currently, AB 1352 (2024) will eliminate even our ability to control local schools by authorizing the censure or removal of board members of school districts who may wish to adopt policies that protect parental rights and may be considered “non-inclusive policies, procedures, and curriculum”. AB 1825 (2024) will remove the authority of schools to decide which books are available to children in school libraries, especially dealing with political or moral issues. AB 5 (2023) now requires each school district to provide and require at least one hour of training annually to all certificated staff on cultural competency in supporting lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and questioning (LGBTQ+) students and to maintain documentation on the completion of the training by each employee.

DEVALUATION OF PUBLIC SAFETY continues to accelerate after the misleading voter guides and propaganda led to the adoption of Propositions 47 (2014) titled Safe Neighborhoods and Safe Schools which raised the threshold of felony theft to \$950 leading to an epidemic of retail thefts and reduced penalties for drug offenses which law enforcement officers contend contributes to the increase in homelessness. Numerous bills have been filed this session by both Republicans and Democrats to chip away at portions of Prop 47, but none completely repeal the act. Proposition 57 (2016) allowed for the release of hundreds of previously convicted violent felons. Law enforcement continues to deal with the aftermath with re-offenders. SB 357 (2022) decriminalized “loitering with the intent to commit prostitution” which not only increased prostitution and had been law enforcement’s primary tool for intercepting sex trafficking. This session, AB 2034 (2024), if passed, will reinstate this as a misdemeanor crime.

DEVALUATION OF THE FAMILY began with the social upheaval in the decade of the 60’s. California dealt the first blow with the adoption of no-fault divorce by passing the Family Law Act of 1969. Instead of eliminating the acrimony associated with “fault”, it was often simply moved to the next step with child custody disputes. Acrimony aside, the other ramifications have been much more serious. Without the legal siderails of an enforceable marriage contract, the value of entering into marriage has all but disappeared having declined 60% since 1970, and for those who do marry, the divorce rate for first time marriages is 50%. With the devaluation of the intact, two parent family has come major fissures in the foundation of society.

Today’s issues in California that have resulted from devaluation of the family are found mainly in respecting parental rights. Last year, Gov. Newsom signed into law AB 665 (2023) which allowed a minor as young as 12 years old to go without a parent’s knowledge or consent to a residential facility if the parent(s) were opposed to their LGBTQ+ identity or transition. This year, AB 2007 (2024) provides funding to build those facilities called Unicorn Homes. AB 223 (2023) prevents parents or their attorney from accessing court records of their minor child’s petition for change of gender, sex identifier, and name.

DEVALUATION OF THE SANCTITY OF LIFE took off with the 1973 *Roe v Wade* decision. This time the damage was not at the hands of legislatures but a Supreme Court that invented a constitutional right to privacy and extrapolated that into a right to end the life of an unborn child. Though that decision has been overturned, California last year passed a myriad of laws that go well beyond *Roe*. AB 345 (2023) repealed parental notification for their child to obtain an abortion – a direct result of the devaluation of the family; AB 598 (2023) required school to provide information on how to obtain an abortion; AB 576 (2023) requires taxpayers to pay for abortions through Medi-Cal. SB 1196 (2024) seeks to expand assisted suicide, completing the circle of ending the life from the unborn to the elderly.

DEVALUATION OF PERSONAL PROSPERITY is easily seen in California’s ranking as having the highest income tax, highest gas tax, and a high combined sales tax. The exodus of Californians, especially the middle-income, has resulted in the loss of a congressional seat. California’s tax system ranks 48th overall on the Tax Foundation’s 2024 State Business Tax Climate Index. If high taxes did not compel the exodus, the COVID lockdown did with small businesses were closed while large business prospered. Proposition 1 is the latest attack through taxation by increasing the state’s bonded indebtedness. (see last month’s newsletter). AB 1783 (2024), a bill we strongly support, will defund all Medi-Cal spending for health care for illegal immigrants. 2023 saw the passage of the final piece of legislation that the Democrats have enacted granted universal health care for illegal immigrants at an estimated cost of \$4B. Given the history of the Medicaid program, this cost grossly underestimates the cost in out years as this population increases and accesses this costly benefit. The cost is only one detrimental aspect of this policy; another is the overcrowding of the already-stretched healthcare system.

HOWARD JARVIS TAX ASSOCIATION (HJTA) collects over half a million signatures for Repeal the Death Tax initiative, misses November ballot

This article by the Howard Jarvis Tax Association is the best explanation of what Prop 19 in 2020 did. It was touted as a benefit to seniors and disabled, which it was. However, hidden in the bill was a limitation on the exclusion of property transferred between parent-child (or grandparent-child) requiring the home to re-evaluated to the current home value. Prop 19 required the child to live in the home as his primary residence within a certain period of time.. An excellent resource for clarification is the Board of Equalization., including calculation of the exclusion and the necessary forms.

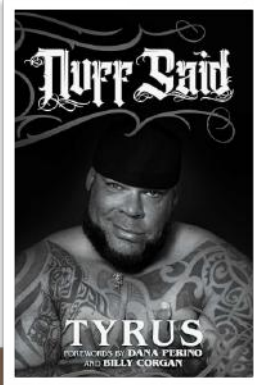
If you are waiting to go to the polls, you can go to any city hall and most libraries to drop off your ballot or request to vote in person. Be sure to take your ballot with you.
