IMPORTANT MUST READ Legislation and Take Action Committee (TAC) Chairman Arlene Wohlgemuth

What's going on in the legislature? Not much that's good.

Having passed the Assembly, three particularly bad bills are up for third reading in the Senate as of 6/26/2023 and are listed below. As you consider the gender transitioning bills, I recommend to you this <u>City-Journal article</u> which closes with this sobering comment from a physician at a major city children's hospital:

This medication [puberty blocker] ...shuts down the activity of the hypothalamus. The hypothalamus is this almond-sized structure in your brain, it's one of the most primal structures we have, and it controls all the other hormonal structures in your body—your sexual development, your emotions, your fight-or-flight response, everything. But it shouldn't be described in such cold physiological terms because your hypothalamus is not just a hormone factory. It's this system that allows you to stand in awe of the beauty of a sunset, or to hear the sounds of orchestral music and to stop whatever you're doing and want to listen. And I always think that if someone were to ask me, Where is it that you would look for the divine spark in each individual? I would say that it would be somewhere "beneath the inner chamber," which is the Greek derivation of the term hypothalamus. To shut down that system is to shut down what makes us human.

CURRENT BILLS

POLICY - PARENTAL RIGHTS AND GENDER TRANSITIONING

AB 223 - Prevents parents or their attorney from accessing court records of their minor children's petition for change of gender, sex identifier, and name, thus hiding a minor's gender transitioning from parents.

AB 665 - The State-sanctioned kidnapping bill. This bill will no longer require professional persons to notify parents that their child will be taken from them and placed in a residential shelter. Children as young as 12 years-old will be able to be removed from their parents' home without any notification or warning.

AB 957 - California courts would be given complete authority under Section 3011 of California's Family Code to deny custody of a child from his or her parent if that parent disapproves of LGBTQ+ ideology.

POLICY - ILLEGAL DRUGS

Hearing scheduled in Assembly Public Health Committee 6/27/2023:

SB 58_- Legalizes the possession and social sharing of certain hallucinogenic/psychedelic drugs. Not surprisingly, almost every law enforcement organization in the state, including the Riverside County Sheriff, registered in opposition.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

It seems that the California legislature is all about rewriting the California Constitution in ways that we may not be fond of.

Two of the Constitutional Amendments discussed below may be a little difficult to explain to our friends which is exactly why they are being offered at this time. The Democrats want to make sure that when they are out of office, the changes they've made will be very difficult to undo. Passing a constitutional amendment raises the bar for future Republican administrations, yet easy for Democrats who have the necessary 2/3 majority in both houses AND an attorney general who will write the ballot description in a way that hides its true purpose.

Therefore, on Senate Constitutional Amendment 2 and on Assembly Constitutional Amendment 5, keep in mind that undoing the affected policies these amendments enable would be a very high bar for future Republicans.

POLICY - YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE ON LOW-INCOME HOUSING IN YOUR CITY

SCA 2 from last legislative session will be voted on the November, 2024 ballot assuming the current session's SB 789 passes setting that date, which it surely will. I have heard several people complain about all the low-income housing going up on Jefferson Street and in La Quinta. While cities are being forced to comply with low-income housing requirements by laws and regulations passed by the Democrats, the state constitution is still on our side.

This is what the Democrats want repealed:

"The California Constitution prohibits the development, construction, or acquisition of a low-rent housing project, as defined, in any manner by any state public body until a majority of the qualified electors of the city, town, or county in which the development, construction, or acquisition of the low-rent housing project is proposed approve the project by voting in favor at an election, as specified."

A future Republican legislature would be able to quickly restore your right to vote with this Constitutional provision in place. We need to work to keep it there.

POLICY – THE SANCTITY OF MARRIAGE

ACA 5 repeals Article I, Section 7.5 which reads: "Only marriage between a man and a woman is valid or recognized in California" and replaces it with:

"SEC. 7.5. (a) The right to marry is a fundamental right.

(b) This section is in furtherance of both of the following:

(1) The inalienable rights to enjoy life and liberty and to pursue and obtain safety, happiness, and privacy guaranteed by Section 1.

(2) The rights to due process and equal protection guaranteed by Section 7."

Now, what could be wrong with that? Isn't it the current status quo? No.

Let's start with what is the definition of marriage. Between LGBTQ+ individuals is the first assumption and would certainly be included. But what about a 40-year-old man and a 12-year-old girl? What if that man were her father? How about mother and son, or older brother and sister, polygamy, and the list could go on. By the way, polygamous relationships are already recognized by New York courts; they just have not yet passed laws legalizing polygamous marriage.

Their arguments in favor of ACA 5 are that the *Obergefell v Hodges* decision by the U.S. Supreme Court overrode most states' laws regarding marriage and that the California Supreme Court has already declared this provision unconstitutional. However, *Obergefell* was not only a slim 5-4 decision but also the basis for that decision was the same as for *Roe v Wade* which we all know was reversed.

Once again, imagine what a Republican majority in California could do once *Obergefell* is reversed. They could grandfather in all the existing "marriages" and go back to protecting the healthiest, happiest, and most stable family structures ever created – one based on the marriage of one man (a human with a y chromosome) and one woman (a human without a y chromosome, just to help Justice Ketanji Brown Jackson with the definition of woman). That would require only a statutory change without having to jump the constitutional amendment hurdle.

POLICIES – EXTENDING THE RIGHT TO VOTE TO PRISON INMATES, AND ALLOWING THEM TO UNIONIZE

ACA 4 – Currently, the state constitution restores voting rights after the sentence is satisfied and the prisoner released. This constitutional amendment would give them voting rights while incarcerated in federal, state, or county prisons.

ACA 8 – Repeals the second sentence in Article 1, Section 6 which reads: "Slavery in any form is prohibited. Involuntary servitude is prohibited except to punish crime." By removing the involuntary servitude sentence, this amendment removes the state's authority to require anything of inmates such as daily chores of cleaning their rooms, working in the kitchen or laundry, etc. Hiring that work done would cost an estimated \$10 billion to the state and countless millions to counties. Further, this policy was advanced by the Communist Party USA as a step toward unionizing inmates. Seriously, that's the goal.

POLICY - WEALTH TAX AND APPROPRIATION LIMITATION

ACA 3 – This measure would authorize the taxation of all forms of personal property or wealth, whether tangible or intangible by the Legislature. Further, it would eliminate the current state and local government restriction that limits annual appropriations to no more than the increase in cost of living and change in population.

ACA 4, 5, and 8 are on third reading in the Assembly – 6/26/2023

Defend our liberties, and fashion into one united people the multitudes brought hither out of many kindreds and tongues.

Endue with the spirit of wisdom those to whom in thy Name we entrust the authority of government, that there may be justice and peace at home, and that, through obedience to thy law, we may show forth thy praise among the nations of the earth.

In the time of prosperity, fill our hearts with thankfulness, and in the day of trouble, suffer not our trust in thee to fail; all which we ask through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen."


