He lost both legs and injured both wrists & right forearm. After multiple surgenes, physical therapies & installed with prosthetic legs, he gradually recovered and retired from the Marines in 2012.






From Velma Hagar, East Valley Chaplin...





From Legislation Chairman Arlene Wohlgemuth...

Bradley Parscale, communications guru for President Trump's 2016 campaign, was our speaker at the March luncheon. Among the many interesting points he made was the importance of properly framing an issue. The messaging on these ten conservative issues polled 80% or greater. Knowing how to say what we all believe will help us as we gain the support of voters in the Coachella Valley, and it is very encouraging to know that 80% of the people we talk with already agree with us.



- * America is not perfect, but being patriotic and proud of the country is good.
- * Discrimination and racism are wrong but are not the cause of all disparities in American society.
- No one is complete without bias, but calling all white people racists who benefit from white privilege and American society a white supremacist society is not correct or fair.
- * America benefits from the presence of immigrants, and no immigrant, even if illegal, should be mistreated. But border security is still essential, as is an enforceable system that reasonably decides who can enter the country.
- Police misconduct and brutality against people of any race are wrong, and we must reform police conduct and recruitment. More and better policing is necessary for public safety, and that cannot be provided by "defunding the police."
- * There are underlying differences between men and women, but discrimination based on gender is wrong.
- * There are two genders, but people who want to live as a gender different from their biological sex should have that right and not be discriminated against. However, this a decision for adults not children; children need to be protected.
- Racial achievement gaps are wrong, and we should seek to close them. However, these gaps are not from racism alone, and high achievement standards should be maintained for people of all races.
- * Language policing has gone too far; by and large, people should be able to express their views without fear of sanction by employers, schools, institutions, or the government. Again, good faith should be assumed, not bad faith.


